## **RMHS MUSIC BOOSTER SUMMER MUSIC CAMP SCHOLARSHIP**

Rolling Meadows High School Music Boosters endorse the concept of RMHS band, orchestra and color guard members attending summer instrumental music, drum major or color guard camps which will not only supplement the individual student's musical education, but also help to improve the quality of the RMHS instrumental music group(s) he/she participates in. Accordingly, RMHS Music Boosters want to encourage such activity to the extent that it is financially possible.

To the extent that funds are available and budgeted, RMHS Music Boosters will provide summer music camp scholarships to interested RMHS band, orchestra and color guard members. Each applicant must be enrolled in a RMHS instrumental music group (including color guard) during this and the next school year, and plan to attend a camp the summer following his/her freshman, sophomore or junior year. Scholarship awards will be in the amount of \$100 per student per year, not to exceed the cost of the camp. Because drum majors and flag captains are required to attend a summer camp, each drum major and flag captain is eligible for a scholarship of up to 100% of the tuition for a summer leadership camp. Applicants are limited to one scholarship award per year. A Music Boosters scholarship may be reduced by the amount of any other scholarship(s) received from another source(s).

All musicians and color guard members will submit a written application to RMHS Music Boosters requesting a summer music camp scholarship. The application will include, among other items:

- Approved music camp selected
- Dates of attendance and cost (tuition)
- A brief statement explaining why the student wants to attend summer music camp and/or how the student expects to benefit from summer music camp
- Evidence of student and parent involvement in Music Booster related activities (ie. working at JITM, selling cookies at a game, selling tickets at a concert, serving as an officer or co-chair, etc.)

The application deadline for summer music camp scholarships will be May 15<sup>th</sup> of each year. Each applicant will be notified by the RMHS Music Booster Scholarship Committee of the amount of the scholarship award within one week of the deadline. Music Booster scholarship checks will be made payable to the respective summer music camps by June 1<sup>st</sup> of the respective year.

Priority for scholarships will be given to students based on the following considerations:

- Applicants who have not previously been awarded a Music Booster scholarship or who received a reduced scholarship
- Applicants who actively participate in various activities sponsored by the RMHS Music Department and Music Boosters
- Seniority by class
- Applications received on or before the May 15<sup>th</sup> deadline

In the event that the total amount of awards to eligible students exceeds the total amount budgeted for such scholarship awards, the Executive Committee of the RMHS Music Boosters will decide, at its sole discretion, whether to increase the amount appropriated for scholarships or change the scholarship allocations to the respective students.
