- 4:55 •Set the block formation for pregame.
- 5:05 •Play through music together.
- 5:25 •Run throughs of combined numbers with on and off the field moves.
- 5:45 •MM students put instruments in band room and go eat PIZZA in Commons Area.
- 5:45 •Junior High students run through performance with Mr. Buti, but without high school students
- 6:00 •Junior High students put instruments away in gym.
- 6:10 •Junior High students go eat PIZZA in Commons Area.
- 6:15 •MM (Marching Mustangs) change into uniforms and sections warm-up/tune in Band room
- 6:45 •MM moves out back door to prepare for the ‘March to the Stadium’
- 6:55 •MM and Junior Highs block-up and move to stadium to troop the stands.
- 7:15 •**Marching Mustang and Junior High Mass Band Combined Pre-game Show Performance**
- 7:30 •Kick-off!
- 7:45 •Junior High students returns to the Orchestra Room immediately after the performance. **Junior High Students are to be picked up at this time.** All are welcome to stay for the remainder of the game, but I request that instruments are put in their parent’s car for security reasons.
