One of six four-year comprehensive public high schools in Township High School District 214. Located in the northwest suburbs, Rolling Meadows High School (RMHS) is 30 miles northwest of downtown Chicago, Illinois. The school community is primarily middle income and residential. RMHS serves the southwestern portion of District 214, which includes Rolling Meadows and portions of Arlington Heights and Mt. Prospect. There are 137 licensed staff members (12 B.A., 125 M.A.).

BLOCK SCHEDULE

ADVANCED PLACEMENT TESTING 2017

82.3% of AP students received a 3 or higher.

SAT:

All RMHS students were provided a District paid for SAT. 464 students in the Class of 2018 took the test and the mean total score was 1075.
