Tickets will be sold the week of April 29-May 3 and will be available before school and during seminar. Details will be provided during the Mandatory Prom Meeting on Friday, April 5th.

Purchaser must be a current RMHS Junior or Senior.

All financial and behavioral obligations to RMHS must be met before tickets can be purchased. If obligations are not met prior to April 24, 2019 you will NOT be able to purchase a ticket.

Guest sheets will be available April 5th, at the Prom seminar and in the main office.

Any necessary forms are to be completed prior to April 29th. ANY SIGNATURES MUST BE OBTAINED PRIOR to April 29th.

All sales are final; there are no refunds or exchanges. A final count of attendees must be provided beforehand to the banquet facility.

Prom is an evening to which many students look forward. To insure a perfect evening, the following guidelines are for everyone's benefit.

- You must bring your RMHS ID to the Prom. Guest are also required to bring some form of identification.
- Once admitted to the Prom, Students will NOT be allowed to leave and re-enter.
- All District 214 rules apply to Prom
- Prom '19 is a school-endorsed activity and school administrators will be among the chaperones. Parents of those students whose behavior is inappropriate will be contacted. Of course, "inappropriate behavior" includes possession of alcohol or other drugs, and/or being under the influence of either. School consequences may also be issued which may included a student not being permitted to participate in commencement exercises.
- The no smoking policy, which applies while on campus, will be enforced for the duration of the evening, including those who are legal age to possess and use tobacco products.
- If you are bringing a guest who is not a RMHS student, you are responsible for informing that person of the rules and asking them to comply with those rules.
